

State Government Responsible Service of Alcohol Program (RSA)

All new staff involved in the service or supply of liquor throughout Queensland must complete the Approved RSA Course within 30 days of taking up employment

Current staff are also reminded that this qualification must be kept current at all times and as it expires every 3 years it may be now time to renew.

The Liquor Act 1992 requires licensees to consider the broader implications of their business, and the possible effects on the surrounding community. Social responsibility is essential to reduce alcohol abuse and misuse, which concerns Government, the liquor industry and the community.
