

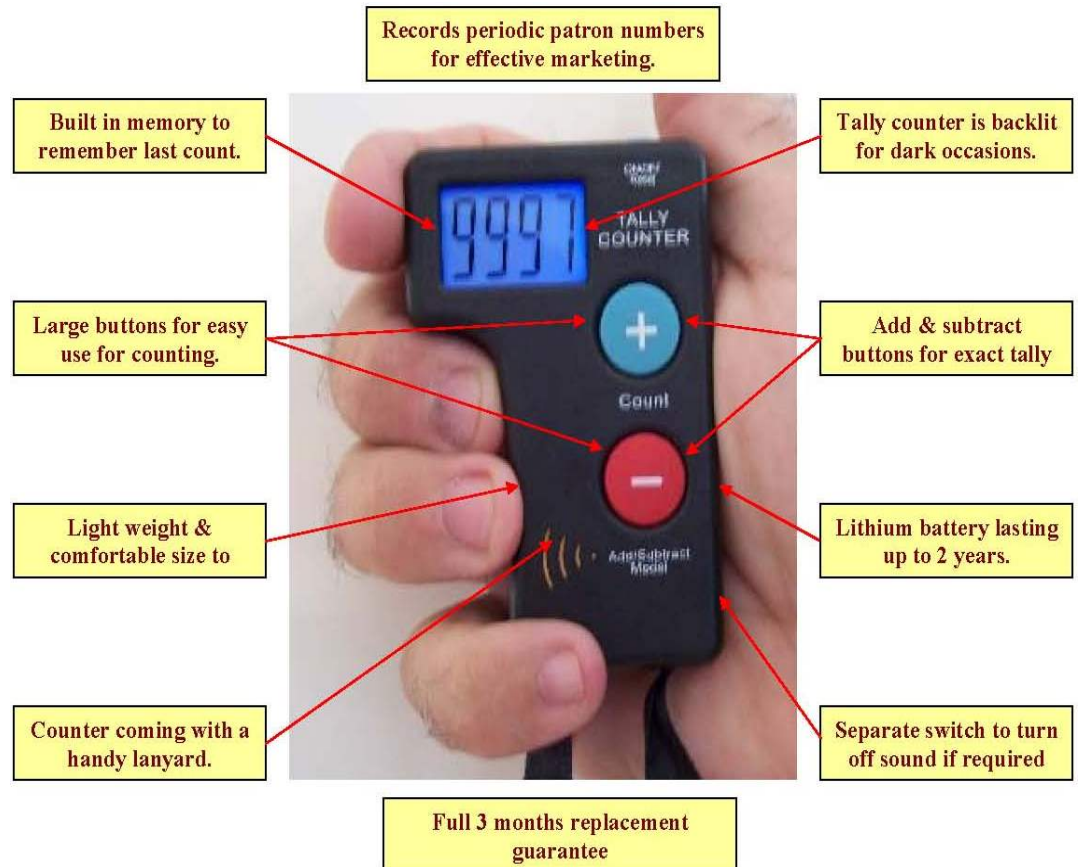
ELECTRONIC TALLY COUNTERS

New Queensland fire safety regulations require a premise that is licensed for over 200 patrons but less than 1000 to implement and maintain a counting system to determined patron numbers.

A counting system as required and defined by section 104KM of the Fire and Rescue Service Act 1990 (as amended) means a system for counting the number of persons entering or leaving a building.

This counting system must be implemented at all times the building is open to the public to ensure the building does not exceed the buildings occupancy numbers.

Now there is counting system that is not only easy to use but will comply this legislative requirement for premises licensed over 200 patrons, but less then 1000 patrons.
